# Privacy Statement for The Lockdown website

This is ABN AMRO Bank N.V.'s privacy statement for the "The Lockdown" website. When you visit our website, ABN AMRO uses cookies to gather information on how you use our website. Carefully read the Privacy Statement before making certain choices concerning the use of the app.

## **For what purposes and on what basis do we process your data?**

ABN AMRO uses analytical tools to measure the use of the The Lockdown website. This allows us to determine which components are most interesting and user-friendly. This enables us to optimise the website. The statistics and reports resulting from this cannot be traced back to individual people.

In addition, the The Lockdown website uses cookies, with your permission. These cookies allow us to show you advertisements for ABN AMRO's IT recruitment campaign in apps and on third-party websites. Your Facebook ID, AdWords and Google's DoubleClick are used for this purpose.

Whenever we process your data on the basis of your permission, you can always revoke this permission. To do so, send an email to [werkenbij@abnamro.nl](mailto:werkenbij@abnamro.nl). We may also use your data if we have a justified reason for doing so which outweighs the interests of your privacy. To determine this, we weigh all relevant circumstances.

## **Do we also share your data with others?**

## **Target group**

The website is not specifically aimed at children under age 16. ABN AMRO advises parents or guardians to take an active role in supervising the online activities of children.

## Your rights

- a) You have the right to inspect your personal data.
- b) Is your data incorrect? If so, you can ask us to change your details.
- c) You can always ask us to delete your data. Insofar as this is possible and permitted, we will do this. However, we are not always required to, nor can we always do this. For example, if the law requires us to keep your data for a longer period.
- d) You can also ask us to temporarily limit the use of your personal data. We can do so in the following cases:
  - a. You think your personal data is not correct.
  - b. We are using your personal data inappropriately.
  - c. We want to destroy your personal data, but you still need them, for example after the retention period.
- e) Do you wish to receive the data you have given to us because you gave us permission for this? That is called 'data portability'.
- f) You have the right to object to the processing of your personal data. We do not always have to honour this objection.

We will store your personal data for no longer than is permitted by law, and only to the extent necessary for the purposes listed above.
